GREEK AFFAIR VENDOR AGREEMENT**

This Agreement made this ____ day of _____ 20____, by and between the Greek Orthodox Church of St. Luke, Broomall, Pennsylvania ("St. Luke"), and _____ residing at _____, City of _____, State of _____ ("Vendor").

WITNESSETH that in consideration of the covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto intending to be legally bound, do hereby agree as follows:

1. St. Luke does hereby grant to Vendor the right to use the space hereinafter described at the fair known as the Greek Affair ("Fair") to be held at 35 N. Malin Road, Broomall, Pennsylvania ("Premises") for a period of _____ days commencing on the ____ day of September, 20____, at _____ a.m./p.m. and ending on the ____ day of September, 20____, at _____ p.m., for the purpose of displaying, demonstrating, preparing, cooking and/or selling the following goods manufactured (and/or sold) by the Vendor during the period of such Fair, to wit:

2. The space to be used by the Vendor as herein provided is located on/in the (fair grounds, tents, or buildings) _____ of the Premises and is shown on the diagram of such area hereto attached and made a part of this agreement as outlined in red and has an area of approximately _____ feet by _____ feet ("Space").

3. The Vendor shall use the Space in accordance with the rules and regulations hereto attached and made a part hereof.

4. The Vendor shall pay to St. Luke for the use of the Space the sum of \$_____ payable as follows: \$_____ on the signing of this contract, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and the balance of \$_____ prior to the installation in the Space of the Vendor's goods and appliances.

5. St. Luke shall not in any manner or for any cause be liable or responsible to the Vendor for any injury or damage to it or its employees or its goods or other property brought upon the premises where the exhibit is held, and any and all claims for such injuries or damages are hereby waived.

6. This agreement contains the entire understanding between the parties, and no other agreement will be recognized as binding upon either party.

7. This agreement shall bind the respective parties, their heirs, executors, and administrators and successors, and shall be controlled by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
